RECYCLING CENTRE

The Recycling Centre is an area equipped for the collection of separated waste from household users. Drop-off is permitted to domestic users, simply by presenting the Italian healthcare card of the TARI (garbage tax) account holder, which will be used to record the types and weight of the materials delivered.

What can be dropped off?

Paper packaging, plastic and metal packaging, bulky waste (sofas, armchairs, etc.), glass, comestible oils and fats (frying oil, oil for preserves, etc.), medicines, batteries and accumulators of domestic origin, used batteries, WEEE (R3, R4, R5), toner.

BULKY WASTE COLLECTION

Those who wish to dispose of bulky ferrous and non-ferrous materials (metal bed frames, mattresses, sofas, furniture, etc.) can contact the **TSA User Office** and make an **appointment** for the pick-up of **up to 3 medium-sized items** from outside your home.

The service provides collection exclusively at street level in a public area.

FREE NAPPY/DIAPER AND INCONTINENCE PAD COLLECTION SERVICE

Families who find themselves in difficulty, needing to dispose of a significant number of nappies/diapers and/or incontinence pads, can benefit from a dedicated collection service using special bags.

The TARI (garbage tax) account holder can activate at the civil **Registry Office** (Ufficio Anagrafe) located at Piazza della Repubblica 4, by filling out the appropriate form to receive a beige bag kit, as well as all the useful information on the correct use of the service.

Opening hours

Monday and Wednesday: 9:00 am – 12:00 pm | Thursday: 3:30 PM – 5:00 PM

The beige bags are exclusively for nappies/diapers and incontinence pads.

The service has an annual duration from the date of activation and, upon expiry, may be renewed by submitting a new request. For information and updates, please consult the website www.tsaweb.it under the section for your Municipality.
